The scholarship covers conference registration fees, meals, hotel accommodations and transportation costs to attend [PRIMA's 33rd Annual Conference](#), June 3-6, 2012, in Nashville, Tennessee. The conference offers more than 50 education sessions related to insurance, risk and loss control, risk management, pooling, schools, human resources, legal and regulatory issues and enterprise risk management. The scholarship winners will be paired with PRIMA members who are experienced risk managers. They will act as mentors and help the students network, gain industry knowledge and expose them to other learning opportunities before, during, and after the 2012 Annual Conference.
